The following discipline guidelines will be used at the discretion of the school administration when decisions are made regarding individual incidents. These guidelines pertain to incidents which occur at school, going to or from school, during lunch period, and during or while going to or coming from a school-sponsored activity. Site administration should contact the District Student Services Coordinator for any discipline incident involving Ed codes 48900(b), 48900(c), & 48900(d).
